Modules and submodules house all the information and content within your courses.

However, you may find that you need to delete a module or submodule from your course.

- <u>To bulk delete modules</u>
- <u>To delete individual modules/submodules from the content tab</u>

To bulk delete every module/submodule from a course, select "Content" from the top of your course homepage.



From the left side of your screen, choose "Table of Contents."



Select the arrow/carrot icon next to the "Table of Contents" and then click "Delete All Modules."
