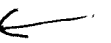

Other: Reinstatement of the Adult Nurse Practitioner program necessitates separation of the didactic content of Advanced Nursing for Health Restoration of Adults from the clinical component so that two laboratory courses can be offered - one for generic MSN students (NURS 7332K) and one for NP students (NURS 7392).

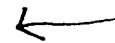
