Momentum Year	The Deans Council and the Executive		
Bob Smith	Committee of the Faculty Senate met this		
	morning and reviewed all feedback received on		
	the proposed Focus Areas. Revisions will be		
	made to the Focus Areas and will be		
	distributed to the advisors. The revised Focus		
	Areas may need to be further revised through		
	the process of identifying the common 9 credit		
	hours for each area.		
Advising	Kirk Johnson has been named as the interim

	start full-time in this role on Monday, April 9 th .		
	Twelve graduate assistants have been involved		
	in advising across campus and these positions		
	will be transitioned into the advising centers		
	formally. Rob will review funding for the GAs		
	who are not currently covered by Centralized		
	Advising to determine where the funding will		
	come from. Graduate Assistants who are		
	currently in other areas but may be qualified to		
	become an advisor will have to give up their		

	current positions if they wish to apply (and are	
	hired) into an advising GA position.	
First Generation	Proposed definition of first generation would	
Students	include those students whose parents have not	
Rob Freidhoff	completed a college degree. The USG definition	
	is much more limited than this definition. If we	
	adopt a definition different than that of the	
	USG, then we will have to be careful when	
	reporting data to the system office.	
	Michael Schmidt spoke about faculty	
	engagement related to first generation	
	students. He discussed the website that Old	
	Dominion University has specifically for First	
	Generation Students. He is exploring options	
	for visual representations for First Generation	
	Students whether it be through a website,	
	medallion, pin, etc.	
	Exploring the definition of First Generation	
	Students illuminated a lot of overlap with other	
	groups of students such as Veterans, Minority,	
	etc. How do we reach these students without	
	further constructing silos for each group? Can	
	we develop a common path to a certain point	
	for all of these students and then branch them	
	to different areas/units that are individualized	
	for each particular group?	
	How do we work with parents of First	
	Generation Students? Campus ESP is a campus	
	portal for parents and would be a good way to	
	stay in contact with these parents.	
	Slack (Slack.com) is a productivity tool that	
	could be used in this process.	
	We need to dentify faculty and staff as First	
	Generation to connect with First Generation	
	students.

	imbedded in different areas across campus.		
	There are special teams in IT that are focused		
	on strategic priorities, e.g., Student Success. A		
	number of IT employees are retiring and new IT		
	individuals will be reassigned to other areas to		
	better support institutional initiatives. A		
	current search will result in the hiring of an		
	individual who will have a focus on data		
	analytics. IT is working on several projects to		
	resolve issues related to student success.		
	Can the process for withdrawing from a course		
	be online while building in points that would		
	require conversations with faculty, DHs, and/or		
	advisors before withdrawing? The process		
	currently does not require signatures or		
	approvals of anyone.
