**Homecoming King Election Resolution**

He/she may also volunteer his/her time outside of the interests of Valdosta State University to attend pageants and or competitions that are beneficial to the University System of Georgia

**WHEREAS**, upon his/her appointment the goal of raising 250 dollars each for the Student Government Association Emergency Scholarship Fund will be expected.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the implementation of the Homecoming King will be in retrospect to that of Homecoming Queen with the current requirements, rules, and regulations that are set forth by the Office of Student Life for the 2014-2015 school year.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** this resolution display support from Student Government Association to the Homecoming Committee to implement the above listed proposal for the 2015-2016 school year, in favor of the majority of the student poll
