Economic Advantage Waiver

As of the first day of classes for the term, an economic advantage waiver may be granted to a dependent or independent student who can provide clear evidence that the student or the student's parent, spouse, or U.S. court-appointed guardian has relocated to the State of Georgia to accept full-time, self-sustaining employment and has established domicile in the State of Georgia. Relocation to the state must be for reasons other than enrolling in an institution of higher education. This waiver will expire 12 months from the date the waiver was granted.

The following initial documentation is required:

- 1. Statement on company letterhead verifying parent's name and address, full time employment, start date, and status for withholding Georgia income tax.
- 2. Copy of lease or Warranty deed
- 3. Other documents may be required for clarification of status such as: tax returns, drivers license, etc.
