

## **Piano Proficiency Exam**

The Piano Proficiency Exam will be administered to students who have completed or tested out of Class Piano IV, MUSC 3132. It will be scheduled during finals week of each spring semester and be performed for a panel of music faculty. The exam will consist of several sections.

- Each section must receive a grade of "C" (70%) or better.
- The entire Piano Proficiency Exam must receive a grade of "B" (80%) or better to be considered passing.
- The Piano Proficiency Exam grade is completely independent from the final grade in Class Piano IV, MUSC 3132. Should students fail (79% or below) the Piano Proficiency Exam on their first try, they may retake the exam two more times. The retake(s) will consist of all sections of the exam that have received a grade of "C" or below. All sections being retaken must receive a grade of "B" or better.
- A student who fails the Piano Proficiency Exam three times will not qualify for entrance into the MAT program.
