



Recital/Powell Hall usage–Spring COVID-19 Plan

All spring semester Wednesday Recitals will continue in studio classes.

Degree and Faculty/Guest Recitals/rehearsals in Powell Hall (PH)

- a. All spring recitals/events in Powell Hall limited to 52 people in audience (stage is separate)
- b. Barbara must have full recital program complete with program notes to create QR code
- c. No printed programs for the semester, but poster with QR code will be available in the office
- d. Please let Barbara know if program will be virtual with no audience or poster needed
- e. No food or drinks allowed in space or outside without special permission
- f. Students not required to attend recitals for spring semester, but can attend in area
- g. Masks are required at all times in the hall for rehearsals and performances
- h. Instrumentalists are required to bring pad or cloth for spit as needed
- i. Masks should be put on during breaks for those that can't wear while playing
- j. Rehearsals will continue to follow 30-minute rule for the semester
- k. All recitals will be recorded
- l. Streaming may be possible once we learn to work with the new system
- m. Video and audio is available to use during recitals
- n. A crew will be responsible for setting up and break down prior to and after each performance
- o. Faculty must input all recitals into EMS as well as any additional rehearsals
- p. Include all information needed for recital and whether or not additional assistance is needed
